All fun shoots including Hawk Poker, Fort Shoot, Squirrel Trail, Adult Long Gongs (Rifle and Pistol), Shotgun (includes Muzzleloader & Black Powder Cartridge) for an additional small fee. Pee Wee Long Gong is free.

THIS WILL BE A BLANKET SHOOT. Prize participation is optional. All blanket prizes must be turned in at the registration table before your scorecard is given. PEE WEE AND NOVICE PRIZES WILL BE FURNISHED.

DESIGNATED CAMPING AREAS FOR: PRIMITIVE, TIN TIPI & TRADERS. Hooker Creek campsites will be open at 9 a.m. Tuesday, April 8th.

DIVISIONS: MEN'S, WOMEN'S, JUNIOR (14-17), NOVICE (12-13), PEE WEE (6-11), TRADEGUN. **YOU MAY NOT ENTER MORE THAN ONE RIFLE DIVISION FOR SCORE.** Costume point given for rifle trail (3 items minimum) at registration. After shooting your registered event, if you wish to shoot through again, pick up a practice scorecard at registration. No shooting on trails without a scorecard.

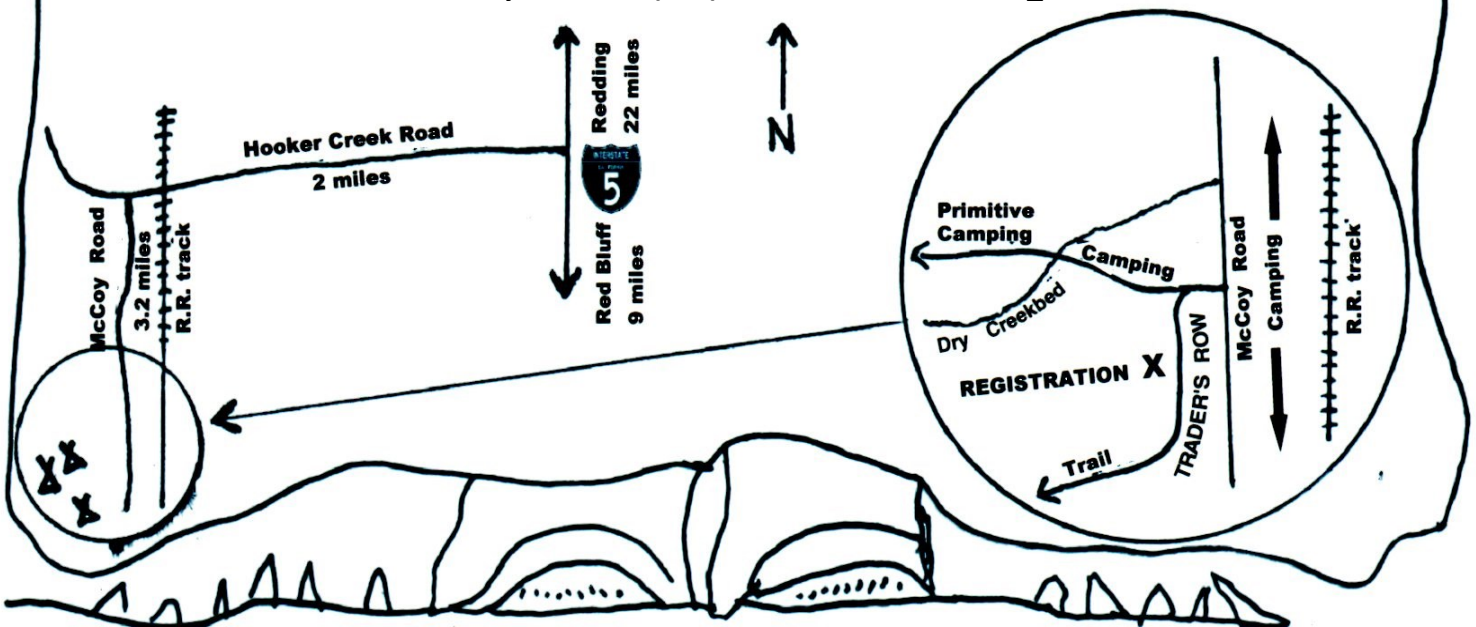
ALL FIREARMS: No scopes, peep sights, or fiber optics for score. Must use loose powder or substitute.

TRADEGUNS: Must be smoothbore flintlock, no set trigger, no rear sight or raised tang screw.

SAFETY RULES AND CAMP REGULATIONS

1. **NO LOADED FIREARMS IN CAMP.** Firearms will be loaded, capped or primed, and discharged on the firing line and only when the range is opened by the Range Master. All firearms will be kept **pointed in the air** until you are ready to shoot at the designated target. Firearms that fail to fire must be cleared on the firing line. Notify officials if you need assistance!
2. No loading directly from powder horn or other bulk container. **USE A MEASURE.**
3. No alcoholic beverages or smoking on the firing line.
4. You are encouraged to use shooting glasses and ear protection.
5. Pee Wees, Novices, and Juniors must have adult supervision.
6. No peep sights or fiber optics.
7. Illicit drugs and narcotics are strictly prohibited.
8. Camping restricted to designated areas. This is private property so please keep it clean.
9. Dogs and other pets to be kept on a leash, and under control at all times.
10. Quiet camp after midnight. No drums after 10 p.m.
11. No motorcycles, ATV's, bicycles, or other disruptive activity in camp. Generators allowed in the tin tipi area briefly during day light hours only. (Medical necessity exempted.)
12. The Bourgeois and Range Master will have complete authority over the ranges and cap areas. Any violation of the rules will justify disqualification.

Please check with registration for a complete list of rules and regulations.

13. Rowdiness, lewd conduct, or discharge of firearms in camp will not be tolerated. Offenders will be ordered to leave.
14. This is a family sport. It is expected that appropriate conduct will demonstrated with due regard for others.
15. Traders' Guild rules will apply to all trade goods. Food service vendors by invitation only!
16. Louderbacks ask that all participants assist us in monitoring unsafe conditions or unsafe acts by anyone. We want no injuries from any cause to mar the enjoyment of our Sport.
